School Goals

By the end of the 25-26 SY, LCL will increase students scoring Developing and above on the GMAS by 7% percentage points in the following content areas: Algebra (34% to 41%), Biology (36% to 43%), and US History (42% to 49%). During the 2025-2026 school year.

By the end of the 25-26 SY, LCL will increase the 4-year Cohort Graduation Rate from 73.54% to 76.54%.

By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, LCL will decrease the number of students missing greater than ten percent of days from 59.3% to 49.3%.
