REGISTRATION

- **Registration will begin Wednesday, March 25, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.** Only online registrations will be accepted. You will find the link to register on our webpage: www.kewaskumschools.org

- **When registering, be sure to use your child's grade level for the current school year.**
- Because some courses have a limit on enrollment, students will be placed on a first come first serve basis.
- **The summer school registration deadline is Monday, April 13 at 3:00 p.m.** This deadline will ensure accurate numbers, which guarantees courses will run, determines the appropriate amount of supplies are obtained, and helps us schedule the necessary transportation.
