Position Vacancy

TITLE: Middle School Football Coach

SUMMARY: The Middle School Football Coach is responsible for leading, organizing, and supervising the school's middle school football program. The coach provides instruction in fundamental football skills, promotes sportsmanship and teamwork, and supports the physical, social, and character development of student-athletes.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Completion of NFHS Fundamentals of Coaching certification. Preferred: Bachelor's degree and Idaho teaching certificate. Coaching experience preferred, but not required.
2. An understanding that coaching athletics involves many other responsibilities and duties beyond practice and competition.
3. Ability to work in conjunction with other staff members, parents, and community members.
4. Knowledge of principles related to motivation of athletes of varying ability levels and learning styles, recognizing areas of athletic potential as well as demonstrated abilities.
5. Expectations of high performance for both athletes and self.
6. Understanding of school and district athletic philosophy.
7. Prior coaching or competitive football experience which clearly demonstrates knowledge of football techniques, strategies, and rules.
8. Successfully pass an Idaho Criminal History check.
9. Ensure proper care and inventory of equipment and uniforms.
10. Current CPR/First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain) and completion of required Concussion Course.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Plan and direct practices and competitions.
2. Communicate actively and effectively with assistant or volunteer coaches, athletes, teachers, parents, administration and media and maintain a professional rapport with athletes.
3. Field set up which includes field painting, supervision of the locker room, and storage areas before, during, and after practice and competition.
4. Supervise assistant coaches and coordinate program activities in and out-of-season as appropriate.
5. Follow all district, conference, and IHSAA rules and regulations and any other

- applicable state and federal laws.
6. Work under the direction of the Athletic Director, Principal and Superintendent.
 7. Exhibit Superior Sportsmanship at all times.
 8. Supervision of the locker room, and storage areas before, during, and after practices and competitions.

TOOLS/EQUIPMENT USED ON THE JOB: Footballs, tackling dummies, sleds, training devices, audio-visual equipment, and athletic training supplies.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Standing, walking, sitting, frequently lifting 10-15 lb. and sometimes 25 lb., occasionally pushing or pulling 50 lb., stooping, kneeling, crouching, twisting and bending, frequent reaching, occasional driving. Environmental conditions working outside most of the time, often cold and wet.

1. One-year appointment. To be evaluated annually. No property right is attached to this position.
2. Begin August 2026.
3. \$1,421.00, starting annual compensation, DOE. Additional compensation provided if team qualifies for state tournament.
