To earn Physical Education credits through Athletic PE, students must enroll in the Athletic PE class, complete the Athletic PE Agreement, and participate in the full season of a CIF-approved, school-sponsored sport. A designated PE teacher will monitor athletic participation, and upon successful completion of the full season of sport, authorize 5 credits.

**Regulations:**

1. Athletic PE is only an option for students in grades 10 and 11.
2. Students must maintain a full academic schedule (6 classes) to be enrolled in the Athletic PE program.
3. Athletic PE credits cannot be earned if a student has already earned 20 Physical Education credits.
4. Deadlines to complete and submit this Athletic PE agreement are listed below and posted on the AUHSD website. There is a specific deadline for each season of sport.
5. To receive credit for Athletic PE, students must complete a minimum of 70 hours of practice, conditioning, or competition under the direct supervision of an AUHSD coach. They must also complete their AUHSD season of sport, including postseason commitments. Students must arrange for additional practice or conditioning time with their coach if they are unable to complete 70 hours through scheduled events. Hours may only be counted during the designated CIF season of sport. Summer hours and hours spent before the official start of the season will not be counted. Students may not earn Athletic PE credit by serving as a team manager.
6. Upon the full completion of a season of sport, students enrolled in Athletic PE will earn 5 credits. Students can earn a maximum of 5 credits per season; there is no partial credit. If a student cannot complete the required hours of practice, conditioning, or competition, they will not earn credit.
7. Per AUHSD Board Policy 6146.1: High School Graduation Requirements, a maximum of 10 of the 20 PE credits required for high school graduation may be earned through Athletic PE.
