

WLHS Rising 12th Graders: Scheduling Worksheet

Use this worksheet to plan out your classes for next year. A few important things before you start:

1. **Add your name to the top of the back side of this worksheet**
2. Please **view the online scheduling instructions**.
3. You will choose a *minimum of 7.5 credits* for the entire year, and *5 alternates*.
 - a. *Seniors are able to request early release/late arrival IF all other credit requirements have been met. (You'll need to plan transportation accordingly)
4. Use your credit check worksheet to identify what credits you still need to take (and need to account for on the worksheet on the backside of this paper) and what credits you've already completed.

Look at the Academic Program Guide (available online on the school website) and consider these factors:

- Does a class have prerequisite or grade level requirements
- Is the class AP and/or Dual Credit
- What do you need to graduate!!!

****Choose thoughtfully; **schedule changes will be limited next year.***

Make sure you have 5 alternative elective choices in case a first choice elective is unavailable.

- Some elective classes may not be offered due to under-enrollment; others will have more students sign up than space available; and others may not fit into a student's schedule due to a conflict.
- You will likely have at least 1 of your alternative choices in your schedule. Make sure they are meaningful choices.
- If you do not provide sufficient alternate electives, they will be chosen for you.

Decisions about which classes are offered are based on your selections. Your choices during scheduling matter!

Scheduling is only complete when you log in to your StudentVue account and enter your class choices under course requests. This includes alternate elective choices.

Ask your counselor during your individual meeting if you have questions!
