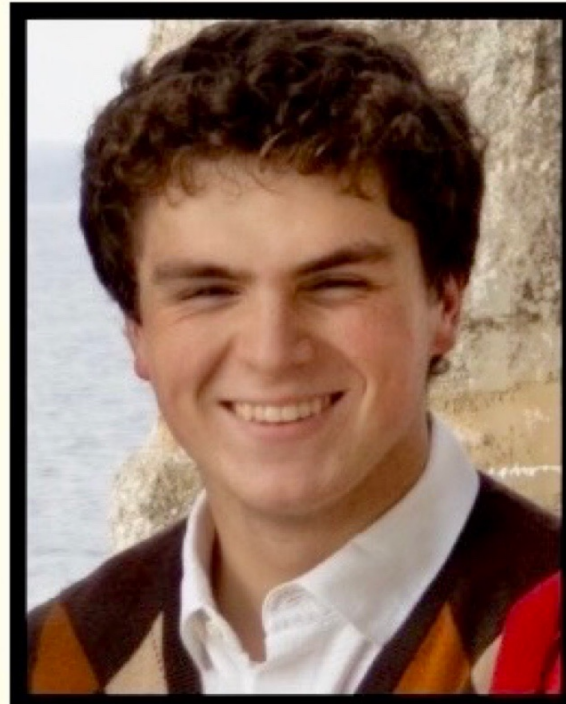


Meet Our Team!
