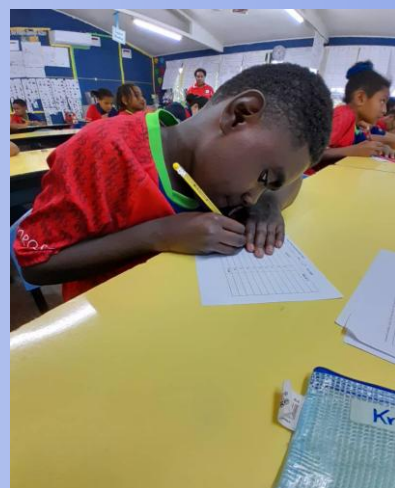
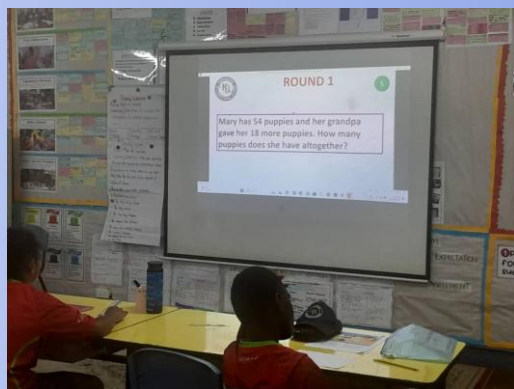
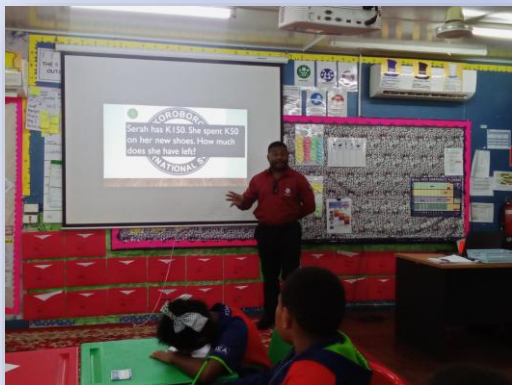

LI: Use inverses to solve problems

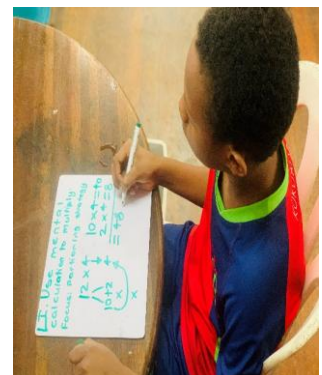
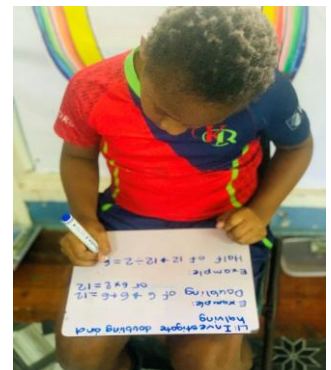
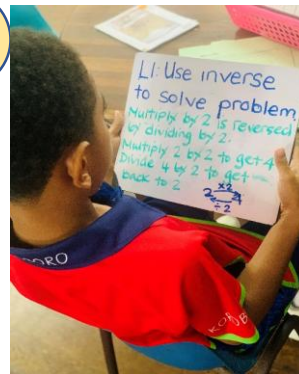
Focus: Inverse

Students broke numbers into smaller parts to multiply mentally and make calculations easier.



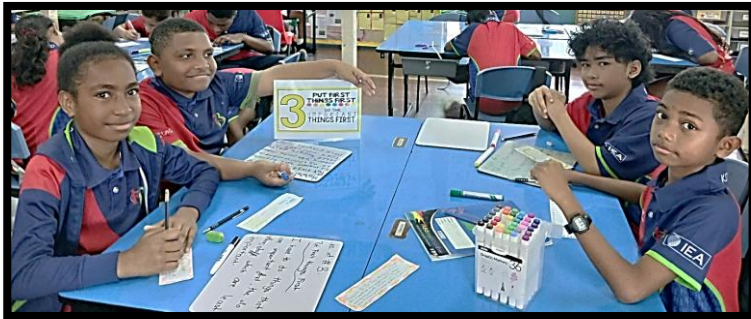
After a lot of modeling and guided practice, students had the opportunity to try the activities on their own. Most students in the class were able to successfully complete the differentiated tasks and show their understanding.

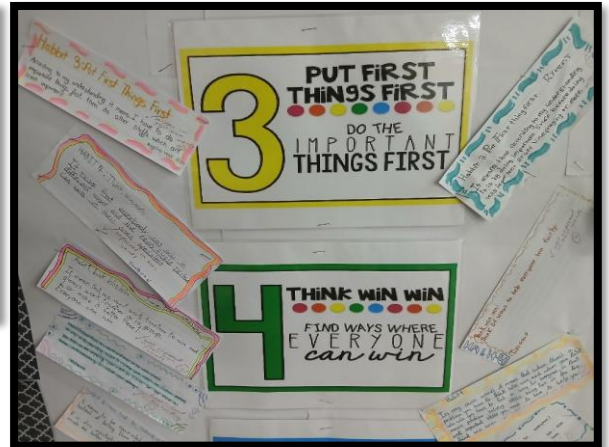
Welcome to Grade 6DM

WELCOME TO THE INFORMER

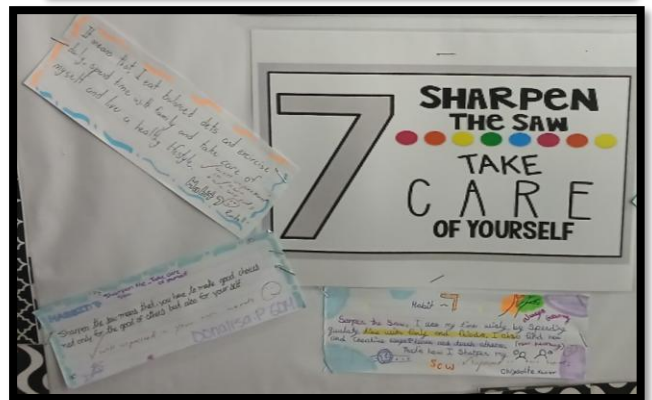

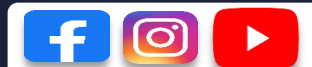
