We hope this message finds you well. As the season changes, we would like to take a moment to remind everyone about the electronic device policy followed in schools across New York State. This policy is designed to help create a safe, focused, and respectful learning environment for all students.

In accordance with the guidelines set by the New York State Education Department and Governor Hochul, all electronics are prohibited in school as they interfere and disrupt the learning environment. During the school day, electronic devices should remain stored away unless a teacher has given permission for them to be used for educational purposes. This helps ensure that students stay engaged in their learning and that classrooms remain focused on instruction.

We encourage families to speak with their children about the importance of using technology responsibly and following school expectations. By working together, we can support a positive and productive school experience for all students. Additionally, please be reminded of the dress code set by our District. It is important that all students adhere to this guideline as the temperature changes. Students are not permitted to wear pajamas to school. Students must wear clothing that covers their abdomen, midriff, or upper chest area. Students are not to wear tank tops, short skirts, or shorts. Underwear is not to be exposed. Headgear is not permitted unless it is for religious purposes.
