

Nurse's Corner



Winter Dry Skin Tips for Families



Cold weather and indoor heating can dry out your child's skin, causing itchiness, redness, or cracking.

A few simple habits can help keep skin healthy and comfortable all winter.

How to Prevent Dry Skin

- Moisturize daily – Apply a fragrance-free cream or ointment after bathing and handwashing while skin is slightly damp.
- Use gentle soap – Choose mild, fragrance-free cleansers.
- Short, warm baths – Keep baths/showers under 10 minutes and avoid hot water.
- Humidify indoor air – A humidifier can help add moisture back into dry winter air.
- Protect skin outdoors – Hats, gloves, and scarves help shield exposed skin.
- Drink water – Staying hydrated helps skin from the inside out.

If Skin Becomes Very Dry

- Reapply moisturizer during the day, especially on hands and cheeks.
- Use thicker creams or ointments for cracked areas.
- If redness, itching, or irritation continues, contact your child's healthcare provider.

When to Call the Doctor

- Cracked skin that won't heal
- Signs of infection (pain, swelling, oozing)
- Severe itching or rash that doesn't improve
