## **PURPOSE:**

Northern Lehigh Youth Athletic Association shall review the letter of intent and interview those chosen for the NLYAA Scholarship. Two scholarships are awarded each year.

## **POLICY:**

All applicants should write and submit a letter of intent for the scholarship and submit it to the Guidance Office no later than April 10, 2026. The letters of intent should answer the following questions:

1. What is your experience in NLYAA?
2. How have you given back to the youth programs within NLYAA?
3. What are your future plans?

All sport directors and executive board members serve on the Scholarship Committee. The only time you can be excused for the Scholarship Committee is if you have a relative that applied for the scholarship.

The Committee will review letters and determine who is most qualified for the award. Qualifications include:

1. Years of playing with the NLYAA organization.
2. Proof that they gave back to the NLYAA community by volunteering to coach or help with a sport in some way.
3. Has plans to go to a college and pursue a specified degree.

The scholarships are awarded to the person who receives the most votes from the committee.
