***Killingly Public Schools provides free supportive, flexible learning opportunities for adults in our community. Whether you want to earn your high school equivalency, improve your English Skills or pursue new opportunities, our program is designed to help you meet your goals.***

**The General Equivalency Development Preparation Classes (GED)** help adult learners earn their high school equivalency diploma. Instruction is provided in the four test areas, Mathematical Reasoning, Reasoning Through Language Arts, Social Studies, and Science.

**Adult Basic Education Program (ABE)** is designed for adults who want to strengthen their foundational academic skills. Whether you're preparing for the GED, improving your workplace skills, or working toward personal goals, our free classes provide individualized instruction in a supportive environment.



Our **Citizenship Preparation Program** is designed to support adult learners on their path to becoming U.S. citizens. The course provides instruction in U.S. history, government, civics, and the rights and responsibilities of citizenship. Taught in a supportive and inclusive environment, this program helps participants build the knowledge and confidence needed for a successful naturalization process

**English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)** classes offer English classes for students whose primary language is not English. Classes offered from beginning to advanced levels. Courses are designed to improve reading, writing, listening, speaking, while developing skills for jobs, further education and cross-cultural adjustment for life in the United States

Come to your appointment and bring:

- Photo Identification (driver's license, passport, etc.)
- Proof of Address (piece of your mail with current address and a recent postmark date, if it is not already on your photo identification)
- Social Security Number (if you have had one issued to you)
- Official High School Withdrawal (if 17 or 18 years of age)
