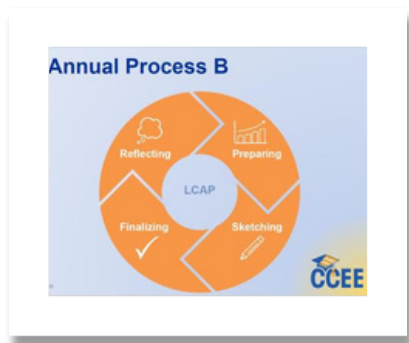


# 2026-2027 LCAP

The TUSD LCAP is our Local Control Accountability Plan to support student outcomes and is an important component of the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). The LCAP is a 3 year plan that describes the goals, actions, services, and expenditures to support positive student outcomes that address state and local priorities. Under the LCFF, all Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) including school districts, county offices of education (COEs), and charter schools are required to prepare an LCAP, which describes how we intend to meet annual goals for all pupils.
