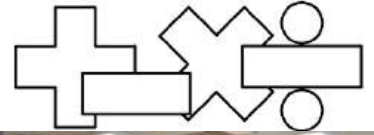
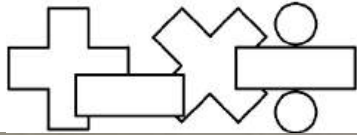
ELA Family Engagement Night – October 1, 2024
