## Welcome Back Students



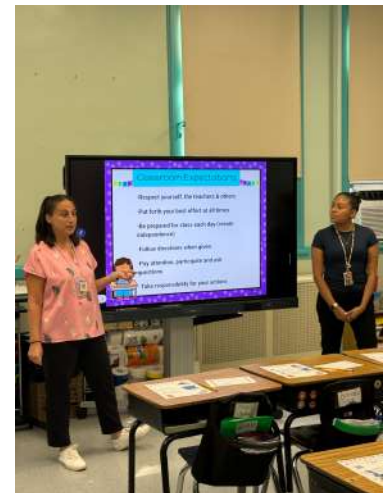
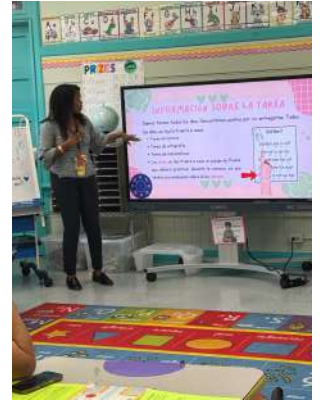
