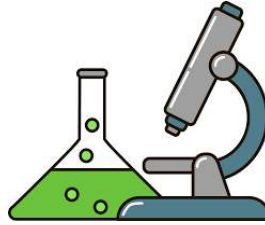

On November 20, 2024, 7th and 8th graders went on a field trip to Students2Science. They learned many things through the teachings of the scientists there and through the many hands-on experiments that they were able to participate in. The students went around to various stations that included:



1. Disease Detective: Students were able to Understand how disease spreads throughout a population and how difficult it can be to control the spread of infectious diseases.
2. Self-Driving Cars: Students engineer vehicles that could autonomously follow pre-designed tracks by using a web-based program.
3. Science Cents: Students explored what chemical reactions do to different materials.
4. What a Pain: Students engaged in exploring the ingredients in pain relieving medication and how it works with our bodies to make us feel better.

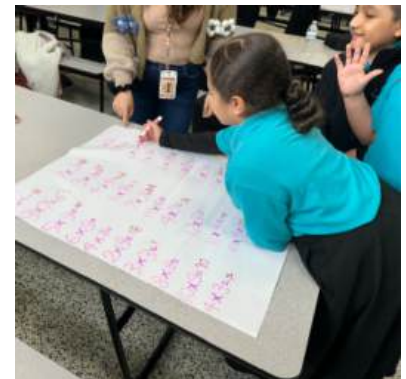


Third and Fourth Grade Multiplication Madness
