In the News – MLVRCS Beats State Average on State Literacy Test

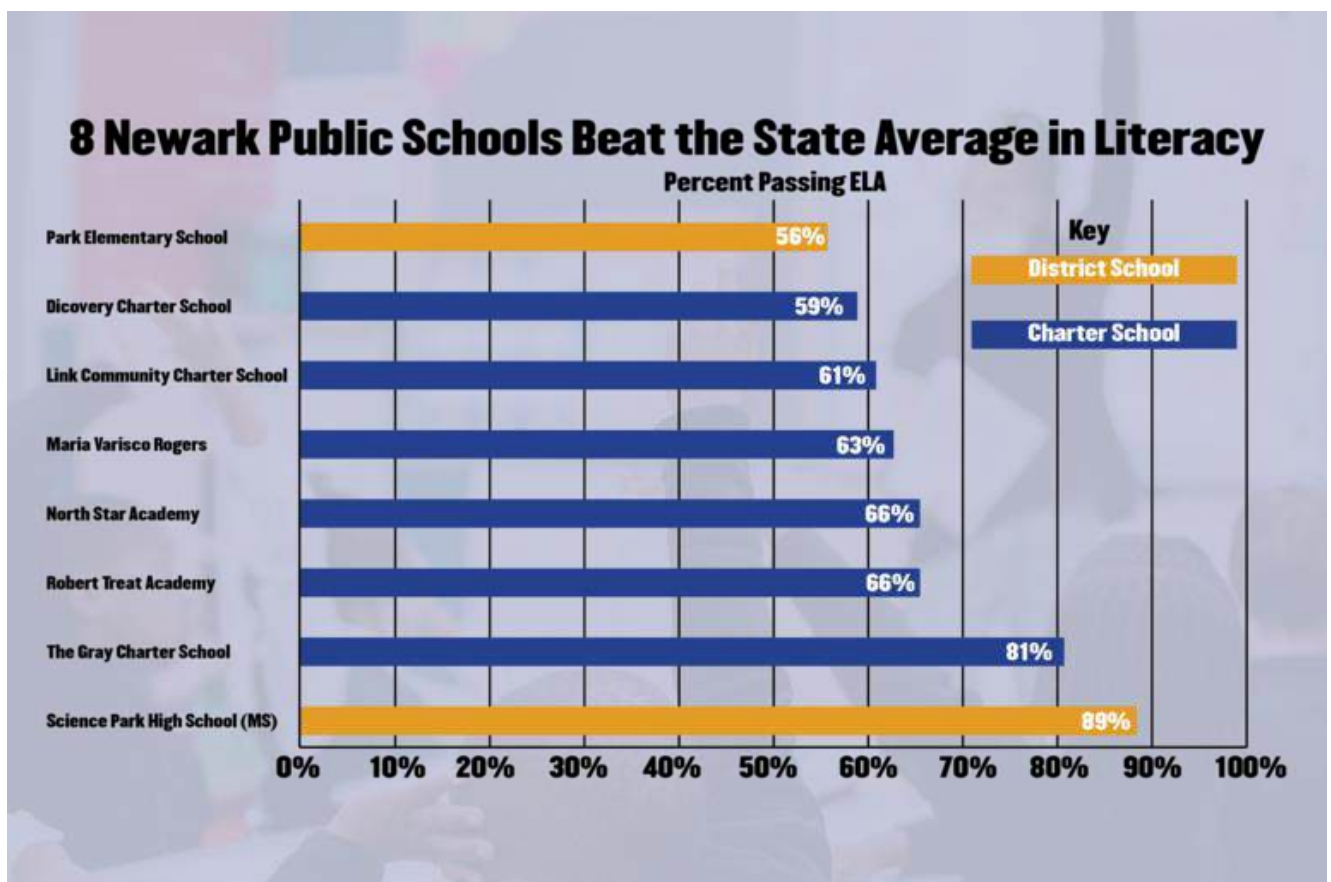
