Dear Families,

Below are the registration protocols for the RSU 63 PreK program. We encourage you to review this information carefully to understand eligibility requirements and the enrollment process.

Registration for RSU 63 resident students opened in early February. To be eligible, students must be 4 years old on or before October 15, 2026 and must be residents of RSU 63.

Registration packets will be accepted beginning on the opening date, and enrollment will be determined on a first-come, first-served basis on the return of completed registration packets. A portion of PreK slots are reserved to meet the needs of students with identified disabilities in accordance with IDEA and Maine Department of Education guidance.

A waiting list will be maintained to fill any vacancies that may occur. If reserved spots for students with identified disabilities remain open as of the first Monday in April, 2027, RSU 63 resident students on the waiting list will be invited to enroll in the order in which they were received.

Please note that submission of a registration packet does not guarantee enrollment. Families will be notified in writing regarding acceptance or waitlist status. The district reserves the right to adjust enrollment in order to remain compliant with state and federal requirements.

We encourage families to register early. Inclusive classrooms benefit all children, as students learn cooperation, empathy, and flexibility while receiving high-quality early instruction. If you have any questions regarding registration, please contact the RSU 63 Central Office.
