Participate in the **FIRST EVER** AED Mapping Challenge at OP Schools and help people who have a heart emergency! Let's show our Quaker spirit and set an example for the nation!

Surviving a cardiac arrest (when someone's heart stops), TIME is CRITICAL and AEDs are a solution!

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is a computerized heart helper. It checks a heart's rhythm and can give it a quick tap to 'reset' the heart and try to get the heart pumping again!

If an AED is near a person who is having a cardiac arrest the survival rates go up SIGNIFICANTLY! If we find an AED fast enough people who recover go from 1 out of 10 to OVER 7 out of 10!

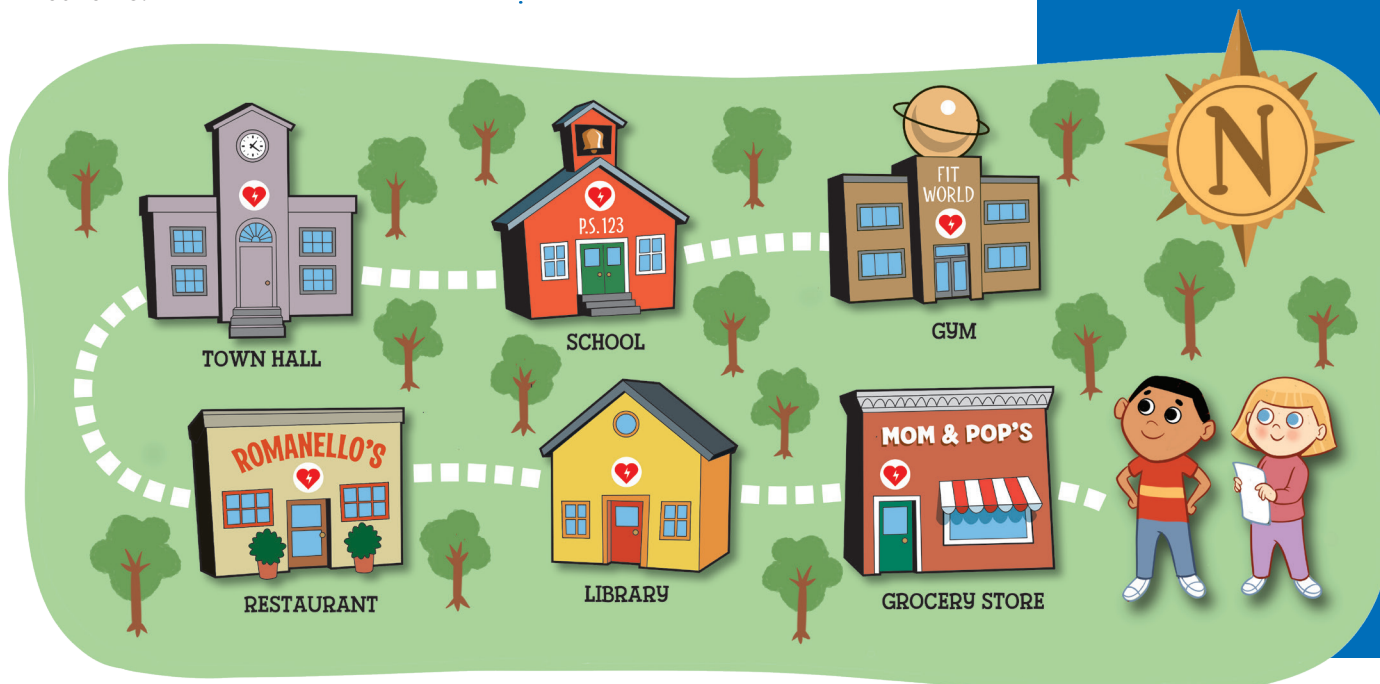
FAST FACTS:

- AEDs are battery operated and can go ANYWHERE
- An AED battery lasts for 2-5 years
- AEDs actually talk to you and tell adults and even kids exactly what to do

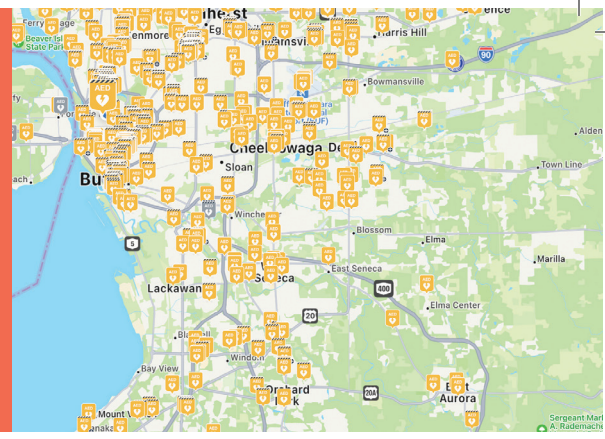
The NEAR Registry

In our community, and across the country, the NEAR registry maps where AEDs are.

When someone calls 911 for a heart emergency, the operator uses NEAR to quickly tell the caller where to find an AED nearby, what it looks like and EXACTLY where it is at the location.

HOW TO FIND AN AED

Look for AEDs in places like schools, libraries, gyms, parks, malls, churches, and offices. If you travel for sports, maybe check the hotel! They are usually mounted to a wall in a small cabinet.

LOTS of places have them now, especially public places, if you don't see it immediately, don't be shy – ASK!

WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN YOU FIND ONE

You found an AED now you need to add it to your log!

Record your AED find on your tracking sheet.

- Where is it- example: Wegman's on McKinley Road
- Where in the building is it- example: Behind the customer service desk
- List the address
