## 2026 PLANT FACILITIES LEVY

### May 19, 2026

- ✓ Plant Facilities Levy on the May 19, 2026 ballot.
- ✓ The levy is being run for \$3M each year for 5 years.
- ✓ Funding for facilities would be available July 1, 2026.
- ✓ Plant Facilities Levy can only be used for projects with a useful life greater than a year; it cannot be used for salaries and benefits.
- ✓ Plant Facilities Levy funding will continue to support deferred maintenance projects and capital improvements going forward.
- ✓ The District does not have a dedicated funding stream for facilities repairs/improvements from the State. ***Levies for facilities are our only funding mechanism for this type of work.***

This essential maintenance and improvement work will touch every school in the Lakeland Jt. School District, keeping our buildings safe, functional, and ready for learning. The levy is an opportunity for our community and the district to continue to partner in maintaining the facilities that students rely on every day, ensuring our 11 schools continue to operate smoothly and meet daily needs while planning responsibly for the future.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$30.24 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The levy will be assessed for five (5) years.
