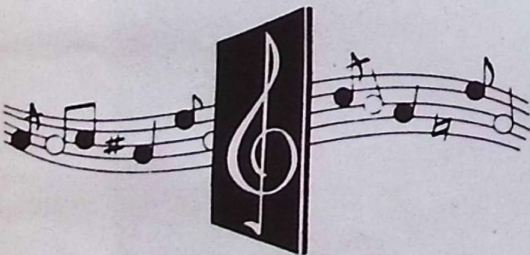

MARCHING IN EXCELLENCE!!



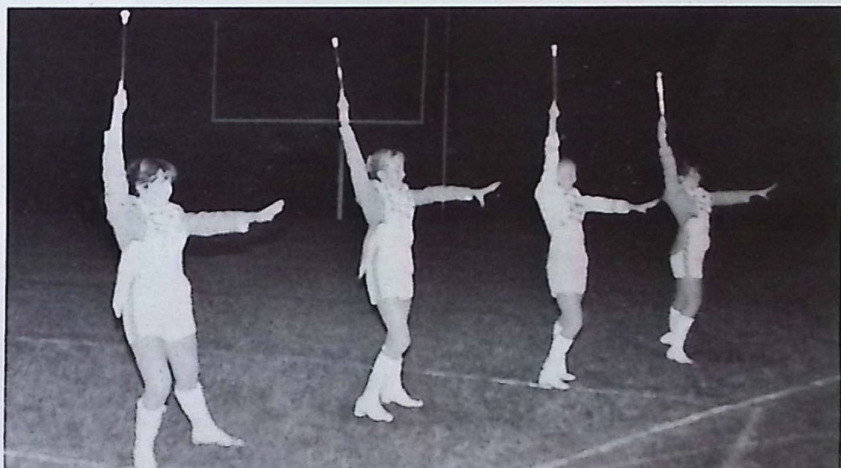
The band gets ready to perform.

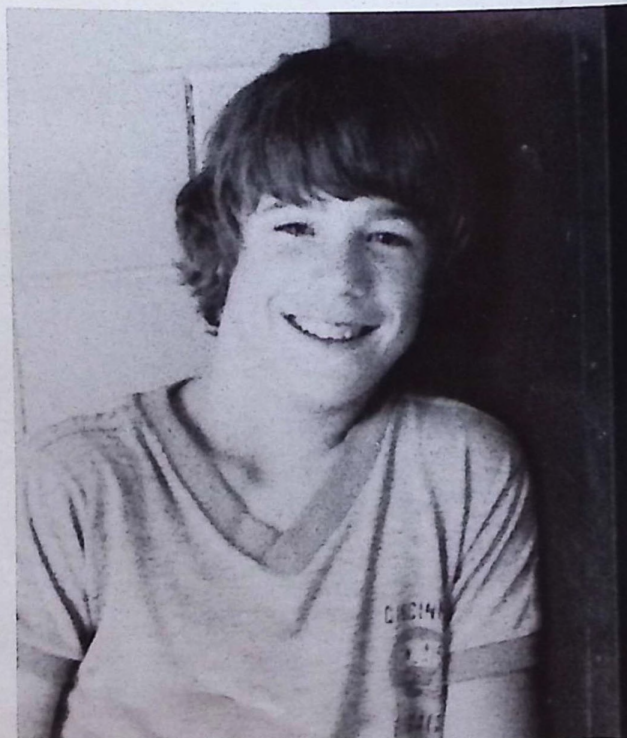

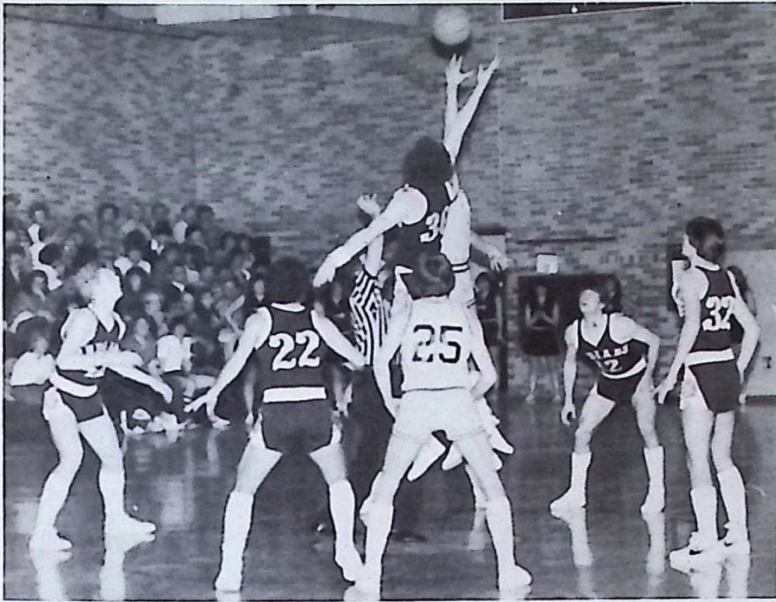

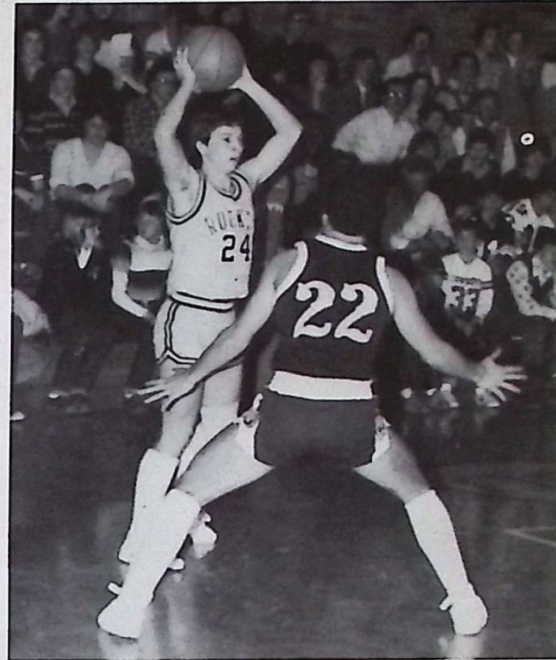

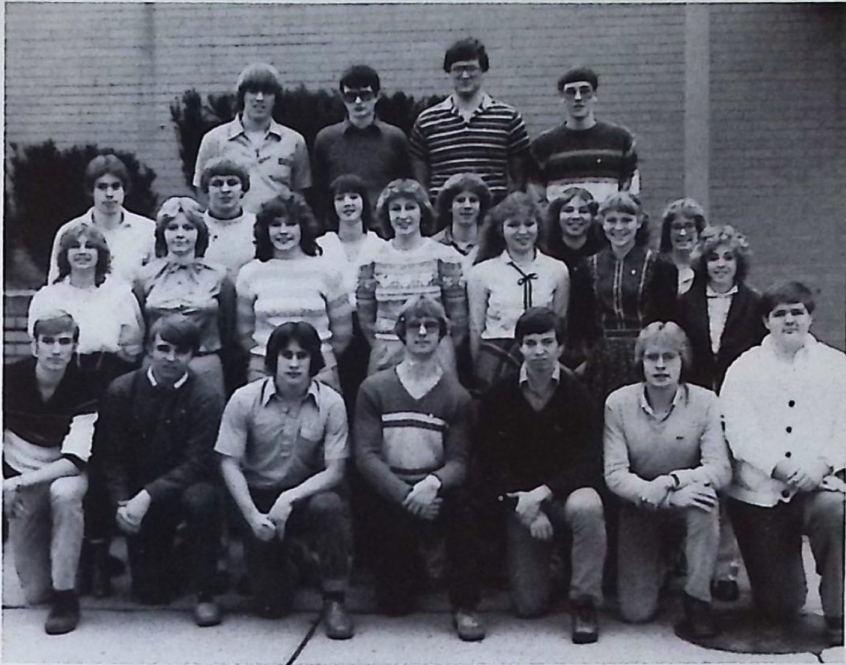
