Dear Senior Parents/Guardians:

In a short while your child will pass an important milestone in life: **GRADUATION**. There are several activities taking place leading up to this special day **PLEASE NOTE IMPORTANT CHANGES ON SENIOR DAY**.

1. SGB is planning a **Decision Day** on **Friday, May 1**, where all Seniors can celebrate their future college and career plans.
2. **Prom** will be held on **Thursday, June 11**, at *The Column's Banquets* from **6:00-10:00 p.m.** The cost is \$75 per ticket. Tickets must be purchased by **May 25**. An invitation with more details will be mailed to all seniors. Guest permission forms are due by **May 15**. They must be approved by the Main Office before purchasing the guest ticket. **Any student requesting to leave school early on this day must provide a note from a parent to Mrs. Healy in the Main Office.**
3. The last day of instruction, **Tuesday, June 16**, will be **Senior Class Day**. (**NOTE NEW DATE AND TIMES**). Several activities have been planned to mark this special day for your Senior. The schedule for this day will be as follows:

5. **Senior Stroll** will be held on **Wednesday, June 17**. Students will meet at the high school at **8:45 a.m.** Students should wear their graduation caps and Iroquois gear. They will be bussed to all three elementary schools for a celebratory walk through. Upon return to the high school, they will proceed to graduation rehearsal.
6. **Graduation rehearsal** will be held on **Wednesday, June 17** at **11:45 a.m.** at the Eastern Hills Wesleyan Church (8445 Greiner Road). Students will take the bus to rehearsal but may drive with parent permission. Please return the enclosed transportation form by **June 2nd**. **Graduation tickets will be distributed to students at rehearsal.**

7. **Graduation** will take place on **Friday, June 26**, at **7:00 p.m.** at the Eastern Hills Wesleyan Church (8445 Greiner Road). Students must arrive by **6:00 p.m.** (doors open for guests at **6:30 p.m.**). Each student will be given five (5) guest tickets at the rehearsal. Graduates are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner and to dress appropriately for the occasion.

REMINDERS

Please remember that Iroquois High School does not sanction either a “Senior Skip Day” or “Senior Prank.”

The following statement is included in our student handbook:

All our events, including Prom and Senior Sunset, are alcohol/drug/chemical-free events. We will enforce the following policy:

If we suspect a student of consuming alcohol, we will have our resource officer and an alcohol detector on hand for confirmation. If our suspicions are confirmed, the student will be dismissed from the prom, serve a minimum of a five (5) day suspension from school, have a Superintendent’s Hearing, and possibly a drug assessment.

S260.20 Unlawfully Dealing with a Child

**A person is guilty of unlawfully dealing with a child when...
He gives or sells or causes to be given or sold any alcoholic beverage, as defined by section three of the alcohol beverage control law, to a person less than twenty-one years old, except that this subdivision does not apply to the parent or guardian of such person.**
