Consequences may include forfeiting the privilege of participating in commencement activities and retribution paid for damage.

Additional prom information

- Prom ticket sales are April 7 – 10. Tickets are required and must be purchased in advance. Pre-sale tickets are \$70 per person. No ticket sales at the door. Purchase your prom ticket in your PaySchools Central account by Friday, April 10. Deadline for pre-sale price is 3:00 pm.
- Guests must be in high school or 1 year removed from high school graduation; must have the prom guest form filled out by their school administrator if a non-RHS student.
- Tickets purchased April 11th through April 14th at 3:00 p.m. will incur an additional charge of \$25 per ticket.
- NO tickets may be purchased after April 14th at 3:00p.m.
- No refunds will be issued. (Emergency situations will be considered by administration.)
- Prom contracts are required for all participants. Even after you purchase tickets online, you must submit your completed prom contract by April 14th at 3:00 pm. These forms must be submitted to Mrs. Repp before you may select your table assignments and prior to admittance to prom.
- **Prom Table Sign-Up April 17th via Google Forms:** Seating will be first come first serve. 10 students per table. You must submit payment and a signed prom contract in order to sign-up for a table. No exceptions will be made. No tables or seats will be held without signed prom contracts and payment.

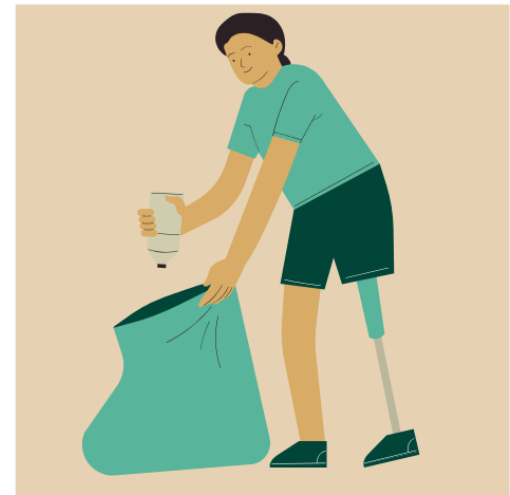
