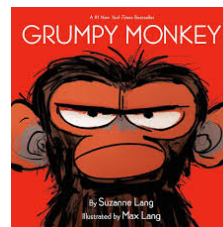
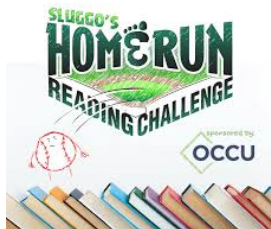

State testing is around the corner. We sent the 30-day testing notice via Seesaw on March 2nd.

Here are the testing dates:

English Language Arts	April 27 - May 1
Mathematics	May 11 - May 15
Science (5th Grade Only)	May 18 - May 22

OPT OUT & EXEMPTION DESCRIPTION OF RIGHTS (DUE BY APRIL 22)

Oregon law (ORS 329.479) permits parents/guardians and adult students* to annually opt out of Oregon's statewide summative tests in English Language Arts (ELA) and/or Mathematics by submitting this form to the school the student attends. The school shall provide any student who is excused from a statewide ELA or mathematics test with supervised study time while other students are testing.

Under Oregon Administrative Rule 581-021-0009, parents may request that their student be exempted from taking the Oregon State Assessment System (OSAS) Science to accommodate a student's disability or religious beliefs. This request will be evaluated and reviewed by the district before approval. * For Science exemption, the family must propose an alternative individualized learning activity for the student that meets the same goals that would be accomplished by participation in state testing. I also acknowledge that district staff will follow up with me to review the alternate learning activity proposed.

You may also receive a printed form to complete from the school administrator or school testing coordinator.
