Position Summary

The Head Water Polo Coach organizes and oversees all aspects of the high school water polo program including planning practices, coaching student-athletes, supervising assistant coaches, and ensuring compliance with District, League, and CIF policies. The coach is responsible for creating a positive and inclusive team environment while promoting the values of Los Alamitos Unified School District.

Essential Responsibilities

- Plan, organize, and supervise all aspects of the water polo program including in-season, off-season, and summer activities.
 - Instruct student-athletes in the fundamentals, strategies, and rules of water polo
 - Coordinate practices, competitions, and team activities
 - Supervise and collaborate with assistant coaches
 - Promote sportsmanship, teamwork, and character development
 - Maintain compliance with CIF, league, and district policies
 - Foster positive relationships with students, parents, staff, and the community
 - Attend required meetings, trainings, and athletic department events
 - Represents the school on the highest professional level with dignity, integrity, strength of character, and ethical behavior.
 - Exhibits moral and ethical behavior and demonstrates dedication and loyalty to the school, the Athletic program, the Athletic Director and other coaches.
 - Properly supervises all athletes at practice, in transit and at games.
 - Supervises, to the extent necessary, all levels in assigned sport (Varsity, JV & Freshman).
 - Monitors the academic progress of team members during the season, and encourages academics over athletics. Place highest priority on student academic success and social development, in addition to athletic development, in full support of the school's instructional program and overall goals and objectives.
 - Provides facility use schedules in advance of the season to the Facilities Department, and keeps the Athletic Director informed of all changes.
 - Maintain open lines of communication with parents through team parent meetings and parent nights. Communicate effectively with student-athletes, families, staff, and administration
