44 Wyoming state qualifiers competing against nearly 3,000 students from 13 districts across the state of Ohio. Students were scored by industry professionals in an impromptu role play or prepared presentation (67%) and a 100-question exam (33%). State finalists were required to do a completely new role play yesterday to determine the overall winners, while prepared presentations presented to a final set of judges to determine winners, all of which were announced last night. The top six in the Principles, Series and Team Decision Making Events qualified for the International Career Development Conference in Atlanta, while the top 5 in prepared events move on to the international conference.

Also at the conference, sophomore London Fisk was elected to the 2026-27 Ohio DECA State Officer Team. The six-person team (five elected, one appointed) is chosen by voting delegates from the more than 100 chapters in Ohio DECA. Her election is the culmination of a rigorous process which started several weeks ago in Dayton where she secured one of just ten nominations. London and the team will be leading and representing more than 7,000 Ohio DECA members at the local, state, and international levels.
