Especially notable finishes included:

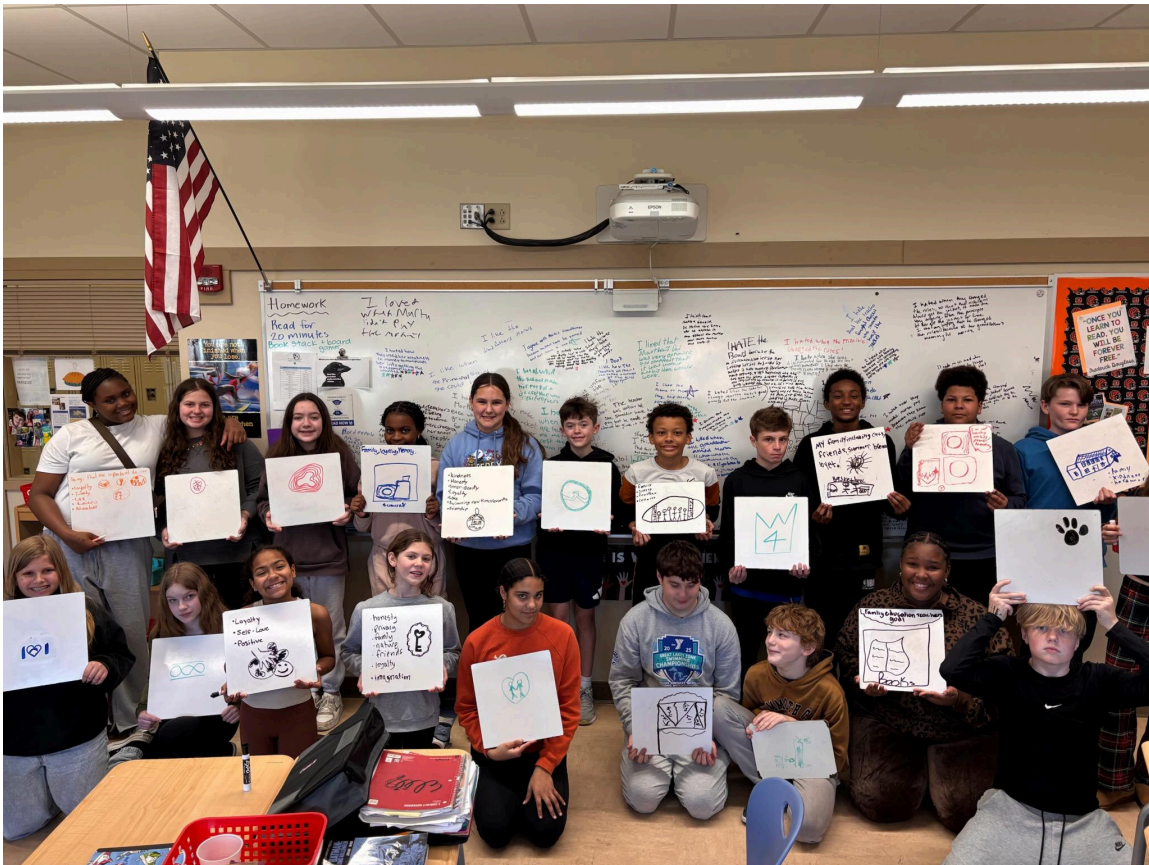
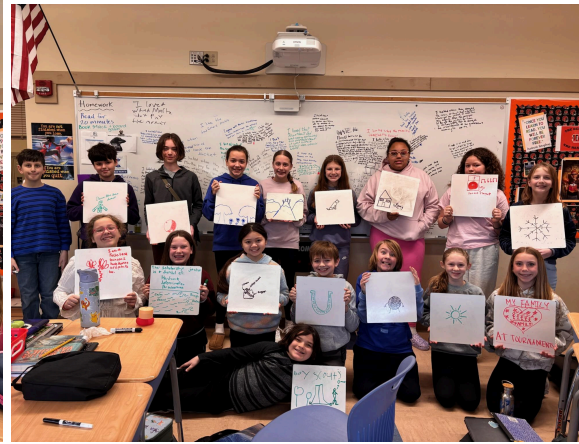
