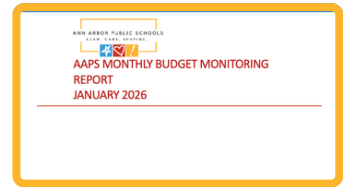
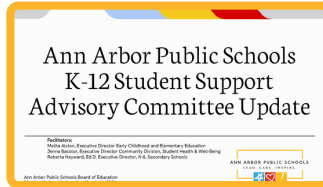
### [Superintendent Update](#)

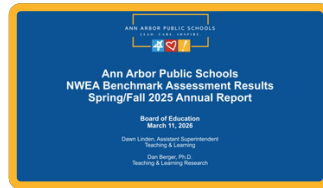

Executive Directors Alston, Bacolor and Heyward presented an update on the **K-12 Student Support Advisory Committee**.

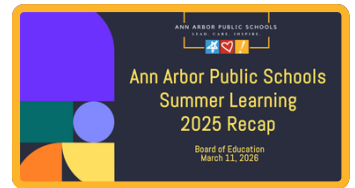

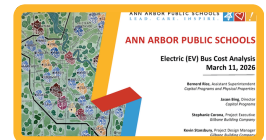


## First Briefing Presentations

## Are all board meetings open to the public?

The Michigan Open Meetings Act (OMA), Act 267 of 1976, mandates that meetings of state and local public bodies, including boards, commissions, and committees, be open to the public to ensure government transparency and accountability. It requires decisions to be made in open session, allows for public comment, and restricts closed meetings to specific exemptions, such as discussing pending litigation or confidential attorney-client communications.
