Grants Policy Language Amendment

Article VI. FINANCES

6.04. Grant Funds.

The Board encourages the solicitation and use of grant funds to enhance the District's educational program, school environment and opportunities for students. The Superintendent, administrators and staff are encouraged to identify, evaluate and apply for grants that will support the District's programs, goals, projects, and priorities. The Superintendent must approve each grant proposal prior to its submission and the Board must approve and accept all grants offered to the District. The Board will not accept any grants from any political influence organization or entity.

The Superintendent is responsible for the efficient and effective administration of grant funds. The financial management and administration of grants must adhere to all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations, any grantor rules, regulations and conditions of the grant award, and the District's policies and administrative guidelines, and shall comply with OMB [Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards](#), 2 CFR 200 and Education Department General Administrative Regulations (EDGAR) Part 76 regarding allowable costs for the use of federal grant funds.

Grants are distinct from gifts, bequests, and/or donations. Gifts, bequests, and/or donations are governed by Board Policy 8.05 (Gifts, Bequests and Donations).
