

MEDICATION AUTHORIZATION FORM

All medication must be delivered to the camp nurse or other designated employee by the camper's parent, legal guardian, or a previously designated adult. It is against Summer Encounters policy for a student to carry ANY medication on their person without physician permission, parent permission and school district permission to self-administer and self-monitor (SC Law S144). All medication will be maintained in the health room. Only non-expired medication in the original container will be accepted.

ALL PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION must have written parental and physician authorization before medication can be administered at camp.

The mandatory forms are linked below based on specific needs. All forms require a physician's signature. Forms from the 2025-2026 school year will be accepted.

[Allergy Action Plan](#) - required if your child has allergies and an Epi-Pen, Auvi Q, or Neffy.

[Asthma Action Plan](#) - required if your child has asthma and uses an inhaler.

[Daily or "As Needed" Medication](#) - required if your child needs daily or "as needed" medication to be administered during camp hours. *This is not the form to be used for Epi-Pens or inhalers.
