

Fraser High School
Athletic Hall of Fame Eligibility Requirements

Athletes and coaches achieving the following honors will be considered for entry into the Fraser Athletic Hall of Fame by the Hall of Fame committee.

1. Earning All-State honors as selected by the Coaches Association, Free Press, or Detroit News.
2. Teams that win a state championship or runner-up will be inducted as a team (the committee may consider other teams).
3. All-American Collegiate Athletes
4. N.C.A.A. champion athletes
5. Olympic games participants
6. Major League team members
7. Coaches who are admitted to the Michigan High School Coaches Association Hall of Fame or a specific sport's Hall of Fame and have completed a minimum of 10 years of coaching service to Fraser High School.
8. Any player or coach whose service to Fraser merits consideration.
9. In rare instances, a non-athlete or non-coach may be inducted, with a unanimous vote of the committee, for extraordinary service & longevity.

Note: There will be a five-year induction delay beyond graduation for any athlete and a one-year delay beyond employment as a Fraser coach.

In addition, an Honorary Service Plaque will list the name of coaches or athletic directors who serve 20 years for Fraser Schools. Coaching at any level (grades 7-12) will be credited toward this award.

Distinguished Service Award Criteria:

Fraser Athletic Club Boosters may be considered for an honorary service award based on extraordinary contributions to the club and longevity.

*Booster Distinguished Service Award winners are not put in the Hall of Fame.
This award is a merit award.*
