### **3. SCHOOL DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS:**

Mrs. Cothron highlighted a publication written by Instruction Partners, Principal Role Clarity. Trousdale County and four other districts were highlighted in this research conducted 2 years ago. Class of 2026 Valedictorian is Kaleb Featherston and Salutatorian is Wyatt Whited. The high school finished spring pictures on Wednesday, February 11, 2026. The Miss Trousdale pageant is March 6<sup>th</sup> and the junior pageant is March 7<sup>th</sup> at the high school auditorium. Admission is \$7.00. FBLA is signing up students to go to State Leadership competition in April with 24 students signed up to go thus far. FFA is competing in Ag Mechanics today in Watertown. National FFA week is next week, and they have a lot of fun teacher appreciation activities and gifts planned. Anna Towns competed in the STAR Farmer interview and placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Region. Clifton Porter competed in the STAR Green hand category and placed 8<sup>th</sup> in the Region. FFA is preparing for their State Convention in Gatlinburg which is the week of Spring Break, March 23<sup>rd</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>.

- Juniors will take the ACT on March 17<sup>th</sup>.
- Summer School student applications are open and will close on March 19<sup>th</sup> after parent conferences. Summer School will be held this year from June 1<sup>st</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup>. We are in the planning stages.

#### **5.C. Project Updates**

- The middle school chiller has been delivered, and the concrete pad has been poured. Bransford will install the chiller mid-week next week and will have it hooked up and ready for use by the end of the month.

- During the ice storm, there were some leaks in the roof at the elementary school. A-LERT, the roofing company, was there today to fix the problem. The roof is under a 20-year warranty.
- Field House: lights in the weight room and locker room are too dim. We are working on a solution to fix the problem. Showers are being installed.
