Middle School Advisory Committee Meeting  
March 18, 2026

The Middle School Advisory Committee met on March 18, 2026, and reviewed the new middle school schedule that has been in place since the start of the 2025-2026 school year. The middle school schedule changes centered around the following:

- STEM Special Area courses in grades 5-8 contributing to implementation of the STEELS Standards
- Redesigned Daily Advisory Period for all grade levels
- Expansion of Regular Education Supports in Language Arts, Math, Executive Functioning, and Well-being
- Family choice of Extensions for additional Art, Music, and PE

The number of students scheduled for the supports, as well as the number of students who selected extensions were shared. Many benefits of the new schedule were highlighted, along with possible refinements. Overall, the structure of the schedule and the course offerings will remain in place for the 2026-2027 school year with parent presentations scheduled starting in April and course selection beginning in May.
