DISCUSSION
Dr. Hood and Dr. Jones explained the newly acquired resources. We discussed how teachers are using Freckle and Lalilo as a student adaptive learning platform for students to practice on their individual pathway, in addition to, targeted formative assessment. We discussed that WriteScore was purchased with school funds to support the writing instruction in grades 3-5. We also were granted approval from the district's assessment office to use DRC Beacon as a formative assessment that mirrors Milestones as well. Teachers are in the process of administering the smaller Beacon testlets on each domain that will

be assessed on the end-of-year Milestones assessment.

DISCUSSION

Winter Screener Progress:

Dr. Hood presented the council with updated benchmark data. K-2 Early Literacy, K-2 Math, 3-5 Reading, 3-5 Predictive ELA Proficiency, and 3-5 Predictive Math Proficiency data were all reviewed and discussed. We discussed how each cohort of students are making great growth. We talked about the importance of executive functioning skills and how this translates to student achievement. Fifth grade students are placed for middle school based on the 4th grade Milestones achievement and 5th grade winter benchmark data.

School Events:

Dr. Hood requested feedback about the school-based events: Curriculum Night, Grade Level Performances. 3rd Grade Milestones Night. Positive feedback was provided for grade level performance, donut mornings, and popsicles with the principal. We discussed updates to Curriculum Night to make this more meaningful and useful for teachers and families. Parents had very positive feedback about the kindergarten parent info night. Kindergarten families felt more prepared and better informed about ways to support their children.
