The Lee and Sarah Giles Scholarship Description

The Lee and Sarah Giles Scholarship is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors or current college students. This scholarship was established to assist students who plan to **major in Education, Math or Science field, or attend a Historically Black College or University (HBCU)**. The following criteria has been established for those students desiring to apply:

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Applicants must graduate from a high school in **Galveston County**.
- College applicants must be working toward an **undergraduate degree**.
- Applicants must meet one of the following:
 - Major in **Education, or**
 - Major in a **Math or Science field** (at any accredited college or university), or
 - Attend a **Historically Black College or University (HBCU)** (any major).

Selection Criteria

Areas of consideration will include:

- Academic achievement
- Character
- Community service
- Leadership
- Personal recommendations

Kindly be advised that the final decisions regarding selections will be made by the Board of Directors of the Lee and Sarah Giles Scholarship Fund.

Requirements for Scholarship Disbursement

In order for scholarship funds to be released:

- Recipients must maintain a **minimum GPA of 2.5**.
- Recipients must complete at least **12 credit hours per semester**.
- Scholarship funds must be used to attend an **accredited college or university**.
- **Proof of enrollment is required** before funds are released.
