Program Highlights

- **College Experience:** Campers will stay in campus housing, engage in sessions on college preparedness and participate in evening activities at USF and in the city of St. Petersburg.
- **Marine Science Innovation:** Campers will address local coastal challenges by developing innovative solutions, utilizing resources from the Florida Institute of Oceanography, Tampa Bay Watch and the Hub Innovation District.
- **Entrepreneurship Development:** Campers will cultivate an entrepreneurial mindset by designing, marketing, and pitching their own projects, gaining essential business and problem-solving skills.
- **Public Speaking Skills:** The program includes training in presenting, and marketing strategies to effectively promote their innovations in front of an audience.
