WHAT: Learn school patrol safety from Safety Education Officers of the Minnesota State Patrol along with First Aid, CPR, Canoeing, Swimming, Online Safety & much more!

WHEN: Sessions are Sunday thru Friday, beginning the second week of June.

ATTENTION!

The summer months are quickly approaching, and Legionville is getting ready for another fantastic season of camp! We want to emphasize that while school safety patrol training and other safety classes remain at the center of the camp, **it is not required for kids to be school patrol members to attend camp.** It is open to any child who will be between 9 and 13 years of age by September 1st, 2026. **Exceptions to the age requirements are permitted but must be approved in advance through our St. Paul office.**

★ **CAMP FOCUS** – The MN State Patrol **WILL** continue to certify children as patrol members at camp. Since this program appears to be changing across the state, with more schools hiring adults for these roles, we have shifted the primary focus to “Safety” alone. We are now expanding to other safety areas, including firearms, archery, online safety, and more. While we have branded it as simply “Legionville Safety Camp” to encourage more kids to attend, this will still include certifying students who require certification for School Safety Patrol.

★ **GETTING KIDS TO CAMP** – In short, WE NEED KIDS AT CAMP! Closing camp in 2018 and then again in 2020 hurt us, and we are desperate to get our numbers back up. Legionville is for any child ages 9-13, and we need your help spreading the word. Campers can be sponsored by a Post, a school, another organization, or family members. Please reach out to your community to inform them. We cannot do this alone and need information to spread quickly!

★ **CAMP REGISTRATION** - The fee is **\$550.00** per camper and can be paid either by check (sponsors and parents) or by credit card online (parents only). For organizational sponsors such as an American Legion Post, a School, or another entity, a coupon code will be issued to the organization upon receipt of payment. The coupon code will then be provided to each sponsored camper's parent or guardian for use at checkout during online registration. This will subtract the \$550 fee from their balance due. These coupon codes must **ONLY** be used by campers sponsored by a specific organization. Please remind your families that these are not shareable and are available only to sponsored campers. ★ **SPONSOR RESERVATIONS** - Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. As a sponsor, please return the camper reservation form along with payment to the St. Paul office at the address below. The form can be sent by email to rhill@mnlegion.org or included with the check by mail. Please **do not hold this reservation application** until you have the names of the sponsored campers. We do not need names initially, and you may lose your first-choice sessions if you wait. The purpose of the application is to ensure that a place will be reserved for your student(s) in the session(s) you select. The names will be added to your reservation once the parent has registered online. This is when the two will be connected.

★ **PARENT RESERVATIONS** – If a parent wishes to send a child to camp independently, all communication and information will be handled directly through the online registration program. The parent/guardian will create an account, complete registration, and pay the fee at checkout. Please share this information with your schools so that we can get as many kids to camp as possible. LEGIONVILLE SAFETY CAMP SPONSORS:

REGISTRATION STEPS AND SUGGESTIONS

1. Sponsor submits "Request for Reservation" form and full payment, payable to Legionville, and sends to Rachael at Dept HQ in St. Paul.
2. Once received and processed, an email will be sent to the sponsor confirming the reservation with a Coupon Code letter attached.
3. The sponsor then forwards the Coupon Code letter to the parents of the sponsored children so they can register the child for camp.
4. Once the child is registered for camp, all communication will then be between Legionville and the family directly.

CAMPER ONLINE REGISTRATION NOTES

- The parent/guardian must create an account and complete the camp registration online. An email will be sent first to confirm the enrollment request. Once enrollment is approved, a second email will be sent confirming enrollment, with a financial statement attached. This will be confirmation that the camper's enrollment is secure.
- The parent/guardian **MUST** complete all required forms online, including Camper Health Information, Family Health Insurance, Photography Permission, Health Care Permission, and Immunization Records, which must be uploaded as well. These must be completed no later than 2 weeks before the first day of camp; otherwise, the camper's enrollment is at risk of cancellation. Forms **CANNOT** be completed at Legionville and **MUST** be on file beforehand.
- Note: a physical is required within 12 months before the camp start date. Documents from the physical exam are not required, but the Camper Health Information form includes a field to enter the physical exam location and date.
