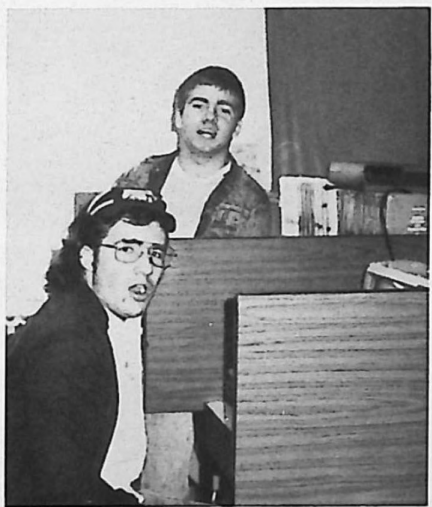

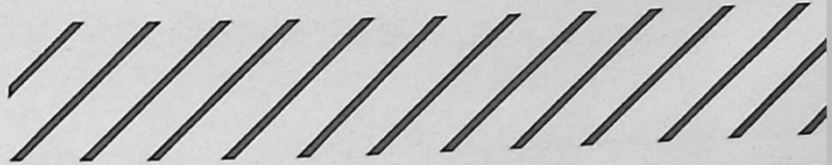

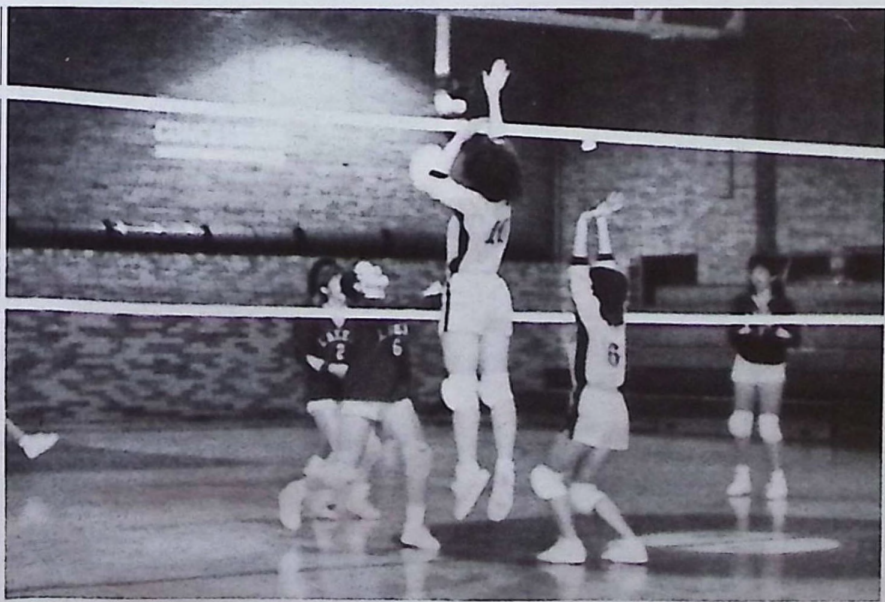

The dance was sponsored by the student council.



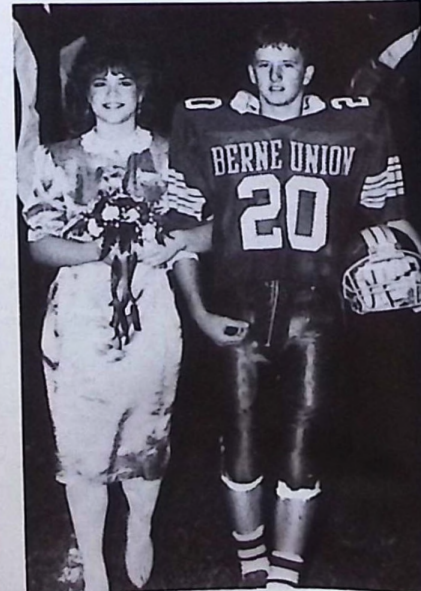

Although we will be losing the senior members of the team, we will begin next year with a number of experienced players.

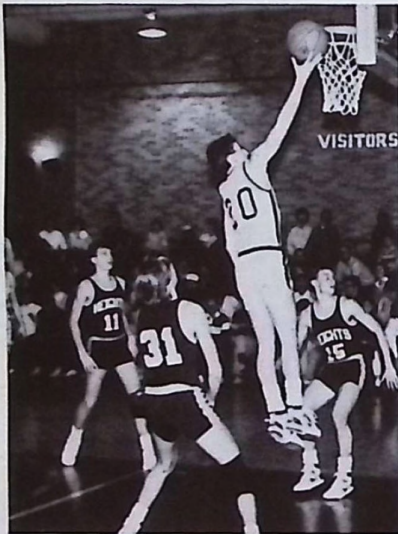

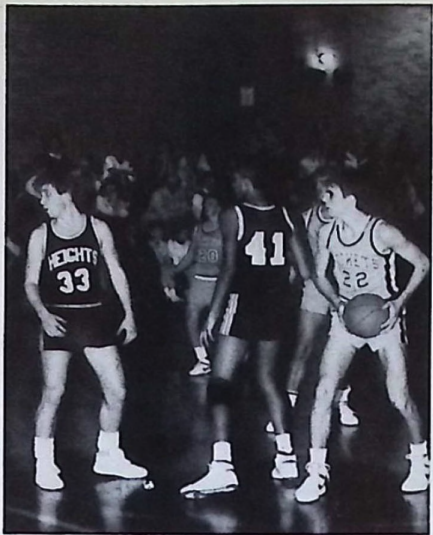

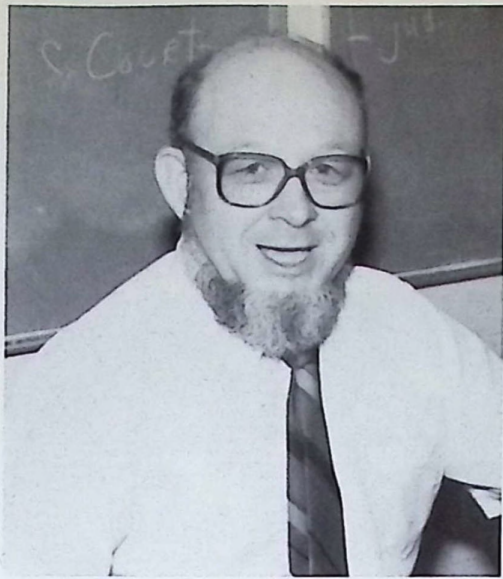
Two of Berne Union's best teachers are retiring this year.

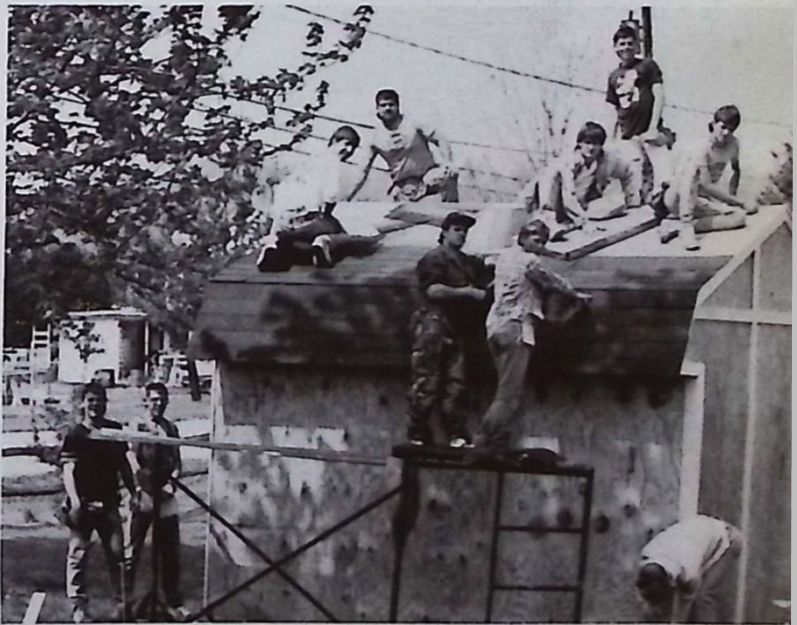

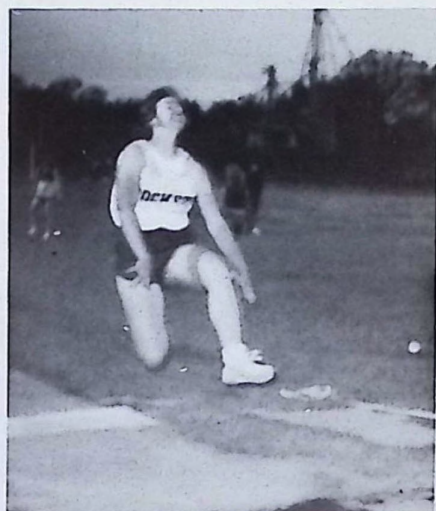

Character • Scholarship

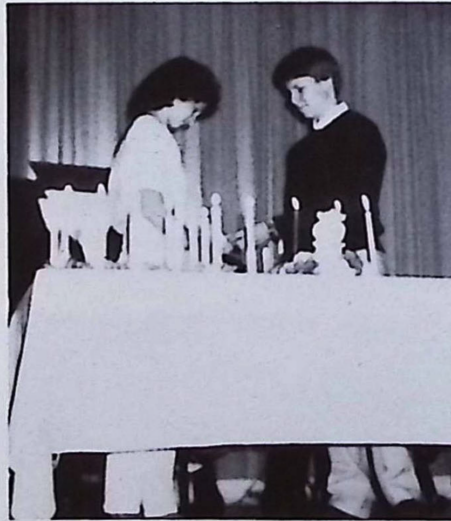
