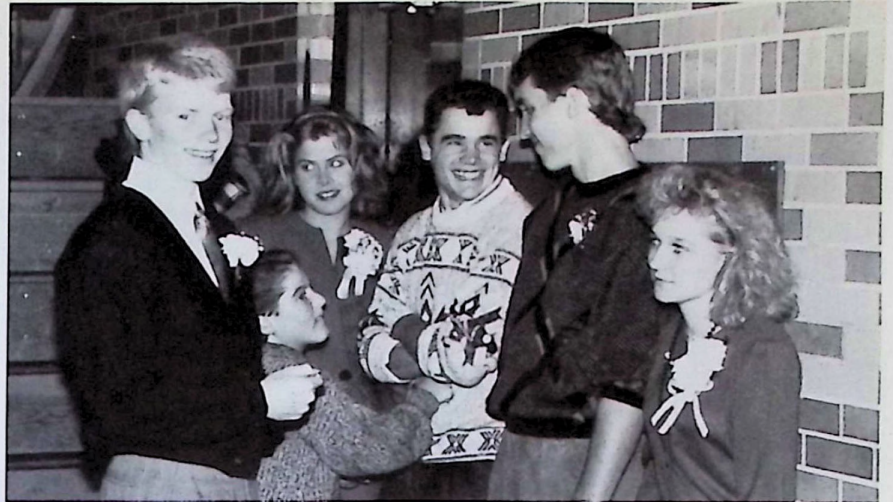

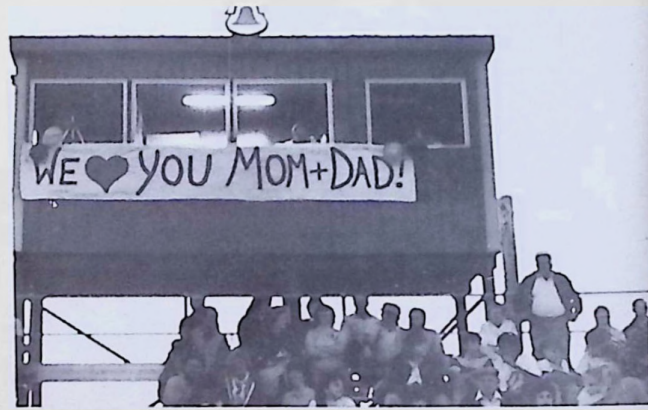

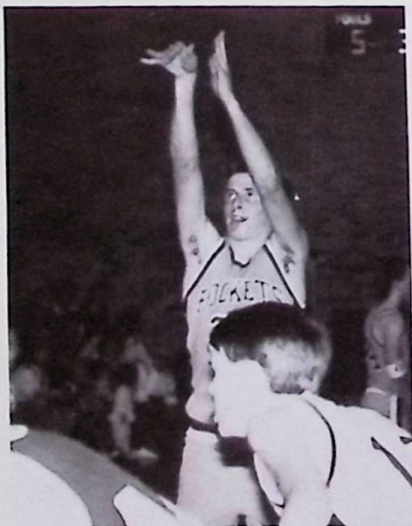
BOYS' BASKETBALL

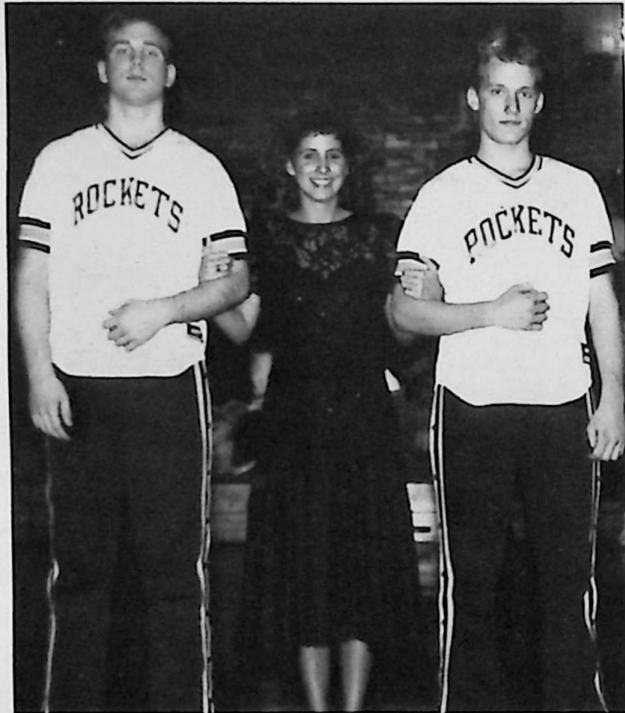


HOMECOMING
