On March 29, 2023, Governor Healey signed into law a supplemental budget bill (Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023) which, among other things, extended the temporary provisions pertaining to the Open Meeting Law to March 31, 2025. Specifically, this extension allowed public bodies to continue holding meetings remotely without a quorum of the public body physically present at a meeting location, and to provide “adequate, alternative” access to remote meetings. On March 28, 2025, Governor Healey signed another law (Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2025) that further extended the expiration date of these temporary provisions from March 31, 2025 to June 30, 2027, without making any substantive changes to the Open Meeting Law other than the new expiration date.
