

Note: Due to various factors, including the volume of participation from districts, contract negotiations for products and services being purchased and delivered within this contract, possible funding changes for districts or ESC Region 11, and other factors, this contract is offered in good faith but does not become binding until September 1, 2026, on either the district or ESC Region 11. If this contract pricing is based on enrollment, the previous year's PEIMS enrollment snapshot submission number from October will be used to determine pricing. This contract is contingent upon the continued availability of appropriations and is subject to cancellation by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. Payment for valid fees or charges rendered by the ESC Region 11 prior to written notice of termination shall be due to ESC Region 11. Early acceptance of this contract is necessary so that ESC Region 11 can plan and prepare to deliver these services. An alternative contract may be offered if this contract cannot be delivered as stated.

Safety, Security, and School Health

The Safety, Security, and School Health contract is designed to increase access to resources and services, improve the efficiency of school and district safety, security, and school health operations, and enhance communication-sharing among the entire Region 11 education community. The following services are provided by the ESC Region 11 Safety and Security department staff and our partners:

Services Available

- Safety, Security, and School Health Advisory Committee Meetings (3 virtual per year)
- Annual School Safety, Security, and School Health Summit
- Annual EOP work sessions and support
- Monthly newsletter containing up-to-date information, including best practices, new legislation, and updates regarding Sentinel
- Crisis Management/Incident Response team
- Support for implementing and monitoring the Handle with Care program
- New School Nurse Academy - Nurses with 0-2 years of experience can participate in a year-long cohort rotating between in-person and virtual sessions. Topics will be aligned to the School Nurse Framework, and we will also cover the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) required reporting.
 - Leading Emergency Response for Nurse Course
 - Nurse Huddle: Professional Learning Network to share insights, hear from guest speakers, and review relevant topics with other school nurses

Additional Services

LEAs can select from one of the following engagements to be conducted at the LEA (50 staff members max). Additional training sessions are available for \$500 per session (50 staff members max):
