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Vettes Out West Scholarship Award

The name of this award shall be “The Vettes Out West Scholarship Award,” and Vettes Out West (V.O.W.) shall administer it.

The purpose of the award is to assist students who best meet our eligibility requirements in pursuing higher education and achieving their career goals.

Eligibility

This award will be presented to Inland Empire High School District Seniors who meet the following requirements:

1. Minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale. **Copy of unofficial transcript.**
2. Acceptance to a Vocational/Technical, Community College, or accredited four-year College or University.
3. Must have participated in 10 hours of community service and involvement in extracurricular activities.
4. One letter of recommendation is required, which cannot come from a relative or peer. (Can be provided by a teacher, clergy, school administrator, or employer)
5. The deadline for the completed application packet is Friday, April 17, 2026, at 11:59 pm—the packet should be emailed to vettesoutwest@gmail.com, Attn: Scholarship Committee.
6. Typed, double-spaced essay of at least 300 words but not to exceed (2) two pages.
Please include the essay with your application.
"We want to hear your personal views. Your essay must be your own original writing, as AI tools cannot capture your personal journey. Applications containing AI-generated text will be disqualified."
