JOB SUMMARY:

Under the supervision of the site administrator, provides an educational program for pupils in grades TK - 8, or a combination thereof, and assists in other school programs as assigned. Creates a flexible elementary grade program and a class environment favorable to learning and personal growth. Establishes effective rapport with pupils' to motivate pupils to develop skills, attitudes and knowledge needed to provide a good foundation for further participation in the total school program, in accordance with each pupil's ability and to meet the California Common Core State Standards. Establishes good relationships with parents and other staff members. Supervises instructional aides, student teachers, and parent volunteers when applicable.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Teach language arts, social studies, mathematics, science, art, health, physical education, music, and other appropriate learning activities to students in a general education classroom utilizing a course of study adopted by the Board of Education and aligned to the Common Core State Standards.
- Instruct students in citizenship, basic communication skills, and other elements of the course of study specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the District.
- Develop lesson plans, comprehensive units of study, instructional materials and provide individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student.
- Translate lesson plans into learning experiences to best utilize the available time for instruction.
- Establish and maintain standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional general education classroom learning atmosphere. Ensure a comfortable and welcoming room environment.
- Use data to evaluate students' academic and social growth, keep appropriate records, and prepare progress reports in accordance with deadlines.
- Maintain effective ongoing communication with parents.
- Hold parent conferences/meetings when needed to discuss the individual student's progress.
- Identify student needs and cooperate with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve health, attitude, and learning problems.
- Commit to professional growth through provided training and activities while actively participating in the schools PLC culture.
- Administer standardized tests and other District-selected tests in accordance with the District testing program and schedule.
- Supervise students in out-of-classroom activities during the assigned working day.
- Plan and coordinate the work of Instructional Assistants, and other paraprofessionals.
- Perform other duties assigned by the supervisor or as outlined in the Maple Certificated CBA
