JOB SUMMARY:

Under the supervision of the site administrator, provides an educational program for pupils in grades TK - 8, or a combination thereof, and assists in other school programs as assigned. A focus on establishing and maintaining an Instrumental Music Program for students in grades TK - 8. Creates a class environment favorable to learning and personal growth. Establishes effective rapport with pupils' to motivate pupils to develop skills, attitudes, and knowledge needed to provide a good foundation for further participation in the total school program, in accordance with each pupil's ability. Establishes good relationships with parents and other staff members.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Teach language arts, social studies, mathematics, science, art, health, physical education, music, and other appropriate learning activities to students in a general education classroom utilizing a course of study adopted by the Board of Education and aligned to the Common Core State Standards.
- Instruct students in citizenship, basic communication skills, and other elements of the course of study specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the District.
- Develop lesson plans, comprehensive units of study, instructional materials and provide individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student.
- Translate lesson plans into learning experiences to best utilize the available time for instruction.
- Establish and maintain standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional general education classroom learning atmosphere. Ensure a comfortable and welcoming room environment.
- Use data to evaluate students' academic and social growth, keep appropriate records, and prepare progress reports in accordance with deadlines.
- Maintain effective ongoing communication with parents.
- Hold parent conferences/meetings when needed to discuss the individual student's progress.
- Identify student needs and cooperate with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve health, attitude, and learning problems.
- Commit to professional growth through provided training and activities while actively participating in the schools PLC culture.
- Administer standardized tests and other District-selected tests in accordance with the District testing program and schedule.
- Supervise students in out-of-classroom activities during the assigned working day.
- Plan and coordinate the work of Instructional Assistants, and other paraprofessionals.
- Perform other duties assigned by the supervisor or as outlined in the Maple Certificated CBA
