

SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT

The Superintendent may delegate authority for the operation of the school system, but they are responsible to the Board of Education for its operation.

The Superintendent has the responsibility for the successful operation of every facet of the school system. Other administrators must accept the thesis that if the superintendent is to assume the responsibility for their decisions, they have a responsibility not only to observe the policies of the school system, but also to support them.

The Superintendent cannot know or be involved in all administrative decisions, but they must participate in the decision-making process when major issues may be involved or a policy is not clear or is challenged.
