Students are encouraged to pick one Visual/Performing Art course and one Vocational/Tech Ed course to make progress towards these graduation requirements.

Opportunity to take REACH college credit courses

Eligibility

The student must have received a passing score (proficiency level of “meets or exceeds”) on the 8th-grade Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment (MCA) in reading.

Participation Limits

A 10th-grade student may enroll in one Career Technical Education (CTE) course during the first semester of enrollment. If the student earns a “C” or higher grade in this first course, the student may be eligible to take additional courses while in 10th grade.

Eligible Courses

These courses are taught by our high school teachers – Mr. Matt Buysse, Mr. David Moriarty, and Mrs. LeaAnne Bot. Students earn both high school and college credit for the following CTE courses.

- REACH Intro to Animal Science
- REACH Principles of Agronomy
- REACH Intro to Business
- REACH Basic Nutrition

If a student is interested in one of these courses, they should talk with the teacher to learn more about the course. Then they should see the school counselor during registration to complete the necessary steps.

Students are not able to drop a REACH college credit course once the class has started.
