



## Student Registration

If you want a Study Hall, please indicate in a box(es). Students can have one study hall each semester (for a max of two study halls).

Students are encouraged to pick one Visual/Performing Art course and one Vocational/Tech Ed course to make progress towards these graduation requirements.

### Additional Opportunities:

#### LEEPStart Welding

This course offers foundational-level welding certifications that student can use to help them prepare for a career in the modern welding industry.

#### REACH college credit courses

Students also have the option to take REACH courses during Senior year. These classes are college courses taught by MHS teachers. Students can earn college credit by taking these classes.

Options include:

- REACH Intro to Animal Science
- REACH Principles of Agronomy
- REACH Intro to Business
- REACH Basic Nutrition
- REACH College Algebra
- REACH Probability & Statistics
- REACH Pre-Calculus
- REACH Chemistry I
- REACH Chemistry II

If a student is interested in one of these opportunities, they should talk with the teacher to learn more about the course. Then they should see the school counselor during registration to complete the necessary steps.

#### High-STEP Health Science Career Pathway

This is a health science career program. By taking these classes, students learn more about healthcare and become prepared to enter healthcare related fields. There are specific courses students taking their junior year to give them the foundation for additional courses their senior year.

- Fall semester of Junior year, students take Health Science Technology
- Spring semester of Junior year, students take Medical Terminology

During Senior year, students will then have the opportunity to take the following classes:

- Basic Nursing (offered both fall and spring semester)
- Sports Medicine: Introduction (fall semester)
- Sports Medicine: Injury Prevention (spring semester)
- Anatomy & Physiology: Introduction (fall semester)
- Anatomy & Physiology: Discovering Form & Function (spring semester)

#### PSEO – Online College in the High School (OCHS)

If students are interested in taking an online PSEO class (or in-person on campus class), they should see the school counselor to begin that registration process. More information can be found in the registration handbook. All PSEO paperwork is due by May 30<sup>th</sup> for Fall semester and October 30<sup>th</sup> for Spring semester.
