 - approve the assignment by the Schuylkill County Land Bank to the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Schuylkill in its Capacity as Land Bank for Schuylkill County of any right in the Schuylkill County Land Bank, pursuant to 68 Pa.C.S.A. Section 2111 (c), and further pursuant to agreement with this Board/Council, to receive 50% of real estate taxes due this Board/Council for a period of 5 years following conveyance by the Schuylkill County Land Bank of real property located within the jurisdiction of this Board/Council.
