- **English Language Arts (ELA):** April 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>
- **Math:** April 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>
- **Science:** April 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>

### ***Middle School Testing Schedule***

#### **All Grades:**

- **English Language Arts (ELA):** April 13<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup>
- **Math:** April 30<sup>th</sup> - May 5<sup>th</sup>

- **Part 1 & 2:** April 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>
