



Scholarships to the Orleans Yacht Club Junior Sailing Program

Applications for summer scholarships to the Junior Sailing Program at Orleans Yacht Club (June 22 through August 14) are now available. Deadline for application submission is April 24, with award winners notified in early May.

The Robert Radtke Memorial Fund, Inc. (Radtke Fund) is a 501(3)c charitable fund which annually provides financial need-based scholarships to the Orleans Yacht Club's Junior Sailing Program (JSP). The fund was established in 1989 in memory of Robert Radtke, a very active sailing member of the Orleans Yacht Club.

JSP Students spend plenty of time out on the water (using three classes of sailboats: Optis, Catalinas and 420s) as well as time on shore with chalk talks and demonstrations. This combination of classrooms teaches solid sailing and seamanship skills ranging from terminology, knot tying, sail trim, safety, and boat care, to advanced sailing theory, racing rules and tactics. Our certified instructors ensure a fun and safe learning experience by combining instruction, educational games and activities, and LOTS of time on the water sailing!

Sail for one week, all eight weeks, or anything in between! *The OYC RECOMMENDS a minimum of 2 consecutive weeks.*
