

# State Testing & Assessments

- End-of-Course (EOC) Assessments are given in: Algebra, Biology, Lit/Comp. II, and U.S. History.
  - All students in these courses are required to take the EOC as 20% of their final grade.
  - EOC assessments are **completed in person at the student's designated home high school.**
  - In EOC courses, teachers may require additional live attendance/participation to ensure students are fully prepared for these assessments.
  - Testing dates and locations will be communicated in advance.
- All other assessments (tests, quizzes, final exams for non-EOC courses, etc.) are completed in Canvas.
  - All final exams count as 20% of final grade.
  - Students who meet set requirements can exempt two final exams at the end of each semester, but **students MAY NOT EXEMPT THE EOC!**
